

SUPERINTENDENT

OVERVIEW

The Superintendent is the daily construction site representative of K2 & has a primary responsibility of facilitating/escalating all questions, concerns, or instructions issued from the Owner to appropriate channels. The Superintendent is responsible with the overall project coordination, management of self-performed work, safety, quality control, & manpower analysis. The Superintendent oversees the site development work and project construction from building permit through final owner walk.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Essential job functions of the Superintendent include:

- Trade management, evaluation, & review
- Collaborating with team members
- Schedule and coordinate overall project, materials, and trades
- Supervise all work to attain maximum quality standards while maintaining schedules
- Act as K2's field representative and liaison architect, trades, suppliers, & building department officials
- Coordinate, cooperate, & communicate with the Project Manager
- Update and maintain project information in Procore in accordance with K2 standards (not limited to daily logs, photos, RFIs, submittals)
- Ensure accuracy of installation for each trade as it pertains to the construction drawings and scope of work for said trade
- Oversee quality control, inspection logs, & safety program
- Review manpower analysis and utilization, and make recommendations
- Review construction activities to ensure that performance of work is carried out in accordance with contract documents and Owner's expectations
- Responsible for coordination of municipal inspection process for Certificate of Occupancy
- Coordinate all owner project turnover activities with various trades
- Coordinate project walk through with ownership
- Facilitate weekly trade meeting
- Personnel evaluation & development of Assistant Superintendent, & Laborers
- Suggest and make recommendations for process improvements

REQUIREMENTS

The requirements for the Superintendent position include:

- 3+ years as a multifamily construction superintendent- Required
- Bachelor's degree in construction related field- Preferred
- Proficient with Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Outlook, Projects)
- OSHA 10-hour certification

- Ability to interpret and build according to drawings and plan specifications
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to lift 40 lbs and to operate heavy machinery
- Valid Driver's License
- Proven leadership ability
- Time management skills, along with multi-tasking, prioritizing and problem-solving capabilities
- Experience scheduling and supervising subcontractors
- Ability to supervise effectively at all levels and with a variety of personalities
