- Learn to read and understand plans, specs, project inclusions/exclusions and the budget to understand all facets of the project during project transfer
- Manage and Own, all parts of the closeout process for each project, both from collecting the parts from operations/field and the estimating
- Provide feedback and update Supervisor weekly
- Perform administrative and office support to Head of Estimating and the team as needed
- Attend weekly company meetings either in person or through Zoom Meetings

Developing/Learning Responsibilities:

- Learn to price a project take-off through learning Quick Bid Software to go along with On-Center take-off Software
- Learn to write a proposal for submission to a client or multiple clients for ITB bid submission or change order
- Learning how to perform a take-ff on new Addenda, RFI's, PR's, ASI's or requested pricing for changes to eventually begin to learn a full project take-off for the estimators to price during a project
- Learn how to place an opening material/submittal order for wall covering and paint materials, communicate to the operations/field team during project turnover
- Visit Sites as needed to learn and monitor the success and quality of project; problem solve with field supervisors and learn to attend Subcontractor trade meetings and quality control review at job sites
- Begin to help support the field with weekly manpower needs for projects and tracking budgets vs actual results for labor and materials purchased for assigned projects
